### ***March Presentation:*** **First Response Computer Forensics**

***March Speaker:*** Larry Jones has served as a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation for 18 years. SA Jones has served his entire career in Baton Rouge. Jones has conducted a wide range of investigations to include Governmental Fraud, Bank Fraud, Corruption by Public Officials, Organized Street Gangs, Fugitives, Bank Robbery, and all forms of Cyber Crimes (Child Pornography, Computer Intrusions, Intellectual Property Theft). SA Jones currently serves as a member of the FBI's Computer Analysis and Response Team (CART). SA Jones has formerly served as the FBI's coordinator for the Baton Rouge Safe Streets Task Force and the Baton Rouge Cyber Crime Working Group. SA Jones is also a Certified Public Accountant.

## ***Officer Nominations:***

The 2006-2007 Officer positions are as follows:

- ***President*** - responsible for overall direction of the Chapter. Writes a "President's Letter" for bi-monthly newsletters, serves as spokesperson for the Chapter, serves as primary contact for ISACA national, approves Chapter expenditures and monthly meeting schedule (i.e., speakers, topics, etc.).

- **CISA/CISM Coordinator** - responsible for answering questions about the exams, coordinating review sessions (when possible), and promoting the benefits of certification. Also assists other Chapter Officers with Chapter meetings (i.e., determining topics, finding speakers, securing meeting locations, etc.).
  - **Membership Coordinator** - responsible for keeping membership lists current (including email addresses for correspondence with members, etc.), welcoming new members to the Chapter (via email, etc.), promoting the benefits of membership, and assisting other Chapter Officers with Chapter meetings (i.e., determining topics, finding speakers, securing meeting locations, etc.).
  - **Webmaster** – responsible for maintaining the chapter website. Also assists other Chapter Officers
- with Chapter meetings (i.e., determining topics, finding speakers, securing meeting locations, etc.).

Requirements

### QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Computer Science, or a related field is Required.

Minimum of five years of audit and/or systems experience with extensive knowledge of operating systems and systems security.

Must have attained an approved certification such as CISA, CDPP, CISSP or other as approved by department management.

Requires strong analytical and organizational abilities. Position requires strong human relations skills in addition to analytical ability. Good communications skills are necessary to negotiate and influence others on commitments to plans and strategies that affect the company.

Must have working knowledge of relative PC software and mainframes. Requires a broad knowledge of information technology and control concepts and application knowledge of business systems.

Must have ability to manage time and personnel on a project and everyday basis (2-4 personnel at a time).

### ACCOUNTABILITIES:

1. Defines, executes and manages Information Technology audits to ensure completion of the annual audit plan while demonstrating sound judgment and decision making, commitment to tasks, persistence in overcoming obstacles, dependability in difficult circumstances, and a sense of urgency about getting results.
2. Assesses and manages Information Technology risks through the successful implementation of audit recommendations.
3. Directs, monitors, and schedules resources and tasks to ensure efficient and effective use while continuously providing coaching, guidance, and direction.
4. Effectively communicates audit issues to all levels of management and

staff personnel within the area under audit review through the timely issuance of discussion issues and audit reports.
